Polio Plus Night at Iowa Energy - February 9th Posted by Nate Burnham on Dec 16, 2012



Rotary will again partner with the Iowa Energy to help raise funds for the eradication of polio worldwide. Polio exists today in only three countries; Pakistan, Afghanistan, and Nigeria. A *60 cent immunization* will keep a child from contracting polio. To this end, the Iowa Energy has priced their sideline \$20.00 tickets at \$16.00 to Rotarians and

their friends and will give back to Rotary \$8.00 for each ticket we sell to the *Saturday*, *February 9, 2013,* 7:00 PM game against the Fort Wayne Mad Ants at Wells Fargo Arena. Therefore, purchasing two tickets for \$32.00 would provide Rotary's Polio Eradication effort with a \$16.00 rebate from lowa Energy, and more importantly, immunize 27 children from the polio virus. In addition to all the above, the Denver Nuggets Dance Team and Mascot, will be the halftime entertainment.

Ankeny Rotarians Donate to Rotary Foundation

Recently, the Rotary Club of Ankeny forwarded a check in the amount of \$3,995.75 to the Rotary Foundation which represents the donations made by 47 members since July 1, 2012. Our club currently has 50 Paul Harris Fellows, (PHF), and 52 members that that are Paul Harris Sustaining Member. A PHF is a Rotarian that has donated at least \$1,000 or more or had that amount contributed in their name to the Annual Programs Fund, PolioPlus, or the Humanitarian Grants Program, over their

lifetime. A PH Sustaining Member is a Rotarian that has committed to donating \$100 or more each year to the Rotary Foundation.

Our club has only 13 members that are not already a PHF or a PH Sustaining Member. If you are not currently contributing to the foundation, please give it consideration. *Did you know the Rotary Club of Ankeny will match each contribution you make to the Rotary Foundation until you become a PHF*? That means if you are not currently a PH Sustaining Member, you can become a PHF with a personal contribution of \$500 or by contributing \$100 per year in each of the next 5 years. Contributing is easy, just ask Denny Hanson or Nate Burnham for a form to consent to at least \$25 per quarter being added to your Rotary Invoice.

Our club also has 13 members with more than 1,000 Foundation Recognition Points. Recognition points can be donated to another individual, Rotarian or Non-Rotarian, to make them a PHF. If you would like to consider a donation or just want to know how many points you have available, ask Denny or Nate.
