

Polio Plus Night at the Iowa Energy February 9, 2013





The Des Moines area Rotary Clubs, including the Rotary Club of Ankeny, has again partnered with Iowa Energy Basketball to help raise funds for the eradication of Polio Worldwide. As you may know, Polio exists today in only three countries; Pakistan, Afghanistan, and Nigeria. A 60 cent immunization will keep a child from contracting polio. To this end, Iowa Energy will give Rotary \$8.00 for each ticket we sell to the

February 9, 2013, Saturday night, 7:00 PM game against the Fort Wayne Mad Ants. In addition, lowa Energy has reduced the price of their sideline \$20.00 tickets to \$16.00 for Rotarians and their friends.

Therefore, purchasing two tickets for \$32.00 would provide Rotary's Polio Eradication effort with a \$16.00 rebate from Iowa Energy, and more importantly, immunize 27 children from the polio virus. In addition to all the above, the Denver Nuggets Dance Team and Mascot, will be the halftime entertainment. Plus, these tickets would make great Holiday gifts or stocking stuffers. 
