Your support makes it possible for students to receive a dictionary for their own personal use that they will be able to use for a lifetime. For some children, this may be the very first book that they have owned. You are truly making a difference in their lives by giving them such an important gift.

Our goal is to reach every third grade student in the United States and you are helping us make this possible. So far this school year, we have reached an estimated 2,025,555 students. Cumulatively, since The Dictionary Project was founded by Mary French in 1995, we have been able to reach an estimated 19,295,569 students. Of these, 5,160 have been sponsored by the Rotary Club of Ankeny since 2006.

What Exactly is Polio?

Polio is:

- A crippling and potentially fatal infectious disease, polio (poliomyelitis) still strikes children mainly under the age of five in countries in Asia and Africa.

 Polio can cause paralysis and sometimes death. Because there is no cure for polio, the best protection is prevention. For as little as US\$.60 worth of vaccine, a child can be protected against this crippling disease for life.

- It can cause paralysis within hours, and polio paralysis is almost always irreversible.

- In the most severe cases, polio attacks the motor neurons of the brain stem, causing breathing difficulty or even death.
- Historically, polio has been the world's greatest cause of disability.

If polio isn't eradicated, the world will continue to live under the threat of the disease. More that 10 million children will be paralyzed in the next 40 years if the world fails to capitalize on its US\$9 billion global investment in eradication.

Rotarians provide many of the essentials needed for National Immunization Days (NID) In India, a single NID involves: 709,000 vaccination booths, 1.17 million vaccination teams, 225 million doses of the polio vaccine, 2 million vaccine carriers, 6.3 million ice packs to keep vaccines cold, 209 million homes visited, and 172 million children immunized.
