Golf Ball Drop Ticket Sales

Have you sold your allotment of "Golf Ball Drop" tickets yet? Do you need more? Tom Friedman has them. Remember they are \$10 each but there are two coupons on each. One for a "free single topping pizza with the purchase of any large specialty pizza from Casey's" and the other for "\$5.00 off the purchase of two entrees from Outback Steakhouse".

When you sell tickets, have the purchaser fill out the stub with their name and phone number, tear off the stub and give them the remainder of the ticket with the two coupons. Ticket stubs and money need to be turned in to Tom Friedman.

At approximately 9:00 PM on Sunday evening, July 15th, at the conclusion of Ankeny Summerfest, balls with numbers corresponding to the numbers on the tickets are placed in a bucket and taken about 60 feet in the air by the Ankeny Fire department ladder truck. They are then dropped, all at

the same time, towards a hole. The first ball in the hole, or closest to the hole if none goes in, wins \$1,000 for the person with the ticket matching the number on the ball. The second ball in the hole, or closest, wins \$500 and the third ball in the hole, or closest, wins \$250.



Gates Challenge Met - But Polio Campaign Continues!

As of the week ended June 2, 2012, Rotarians have raised \$215,724,500 to exceed the Polio Challenge given to us by the Bill & Malinda Gates Foundation. We continue to hear that we are close to the eradication of polio from the earth and protecting all children from this deadly, crippling disease, but our job is not yet complete.

The year to date polio count through the week ended June 2 is only 64 which includes 16 in Pakistan, 7 in Afghanistan, 38 in Nigeria and 3 in other non-endemic countries. This is significantly behind the 181 cases as of this time one year ago. The total number of cases in 2011 was 650, less than half the 1,352 cases in 2010. During the past week only four new cases were registered, one in Afghanistan and three in Nigeria. The week prior to this there was only one new case and it was in Pakistan.
