District 6000 will combine with District 5970 to hold RYLA, Rotary Youth Leadership Awards, a six-day/5-night leadership camp at Wartburg College Sunday, July 7

through Friday, July 12, 2013. Any high school sophomore or junior (classes of 2015 and 2014, respectively) may apply to attend RYLA. Generally, applicants selected have excelled in one or more areas of high school involvement and have potential or proven leadership experience. Applicants must be able to stay for all 6 days of the conference. The cost of the conference is \$400 per student however the Rotary Club of Ankeny has agreed to pay the full cost up to 5 students. All the student needs to provide is transportation to the conference. Applications are due by April 30.
