Ankeny Rotarians Attend Polio Plus Night at Iowa Energy

Several Ankeny Rotarians attend the Polio Plus night at the Iowa Energy on February 8th. A total of 37 tickets were sold or purchased by Ankeny Rotarians. This will result in \$296 being refunded back to the Rotary Club of Ankeny which will then be contributed to PolioPlus.

Since one polio vaccination costs about \$.60, this contribution alone will vaccinate 500 children and prevent them from developing this devastating disease.



Rotary Club of Ankeny By-Laws to Be Amended

The By-Laws for the Rotary Club of Ankeny have not been amended since the club was chartered in 1973. At the meeting on February 13th, revised By-Laws were approved subject to approval by the entire membership. Any amendment requires a two-thirds vote of the membership, at a regular club meeting, where a quorum of members is

present. It is also required that written notice be given to each member 10 days prior to the regular club meeting when the vote to change the By-laws will take place. Each member may expect to receive this letter in the next few days.



Happy Birthday Rotary

Next week, Rotary International will be celebrating it's *109th anniversary*. It all started with the vision of one man, Paul P. Harris, a Chicago attorney. On February 23, 1905, Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram Shorey gathered at Loehr's office in Room

711 of the Unity Building in downtown Chicago. This was the first Rotary club meeting a place where professionals with diverse backgrounds could exchange ideas and form meaningful, lifelong friendships. Rotary's name came from the group's early practice of rotating meetings among the offices of each member. In 1910, Harris worked to expand Rotary beyond Chicago to several other major U.S. cities. Today there are 34,382 clubs and approximately 1.2 million Rotarians in over 200 countries throughout the world.
