Fellows and 13 are "Sustaining Members". A Sustaining member is an individual that has agreed to contribute at least \$100 per year to the Rotary Foundation. That leaves 19 members that are not already a PHF or currently contributing to the Foundation. Steve SchraderBachar, Foundation Chairman for the club plans to be contacting each member that is not currently contributing to the Foundation to discuss the mission of The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International which is: "To enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty."

A Rotarian becomes a Paul Harris Fellow after he has contributed \$1,000 to the Foundation or a combination of recognition points and dollars totaling 1,000 has been contributed in his name. Donations made by members of the Ankeny club that are not as yet a PHF, are matched by donation from the club. A member also receives one recognition point for each dollar contributed to the Foundation. These recognition points can then be donated to another member of the club, family member, or any other non-Rotarian. Our club currently has 10 members with over 1,000 recognition points that could be donated to make someone else a PHF. In each of the past seven years, the Rotary Club of Ankeny has been a major sponsor of Ankeny Parks & Recreation's Youth in Parks Summer Camp Program. Whitney Burger attended the noon meeting on April

22nd and received a check in the amount of \$1,000 from President Dirk Westercamp for sponsorship of the 2014 program.

During the past 5 years, 520 Ankeny youth have participated in the Youth in Parks Summer Camp Program in Ankeny. Each week-long session involves youth in grades 6 to 9 in a half day of community service and a half day of recreation. The program is designed for the participants to develop a sense of community pride through public service.



FTC Robotics Team Demonstrate their Robots at Rotary

Rich Job is a mentor for the Ankeny High School "FIRST Tech Competition" Robotics team. On May 20th, he had his team bring their robots to Rotary and talk about this project.

FTC is designed for students in grades 7-12 to compete head to head, using a sports model. Teams are responsible for designing, building, and programming their robots to compete in an alliance format against other teams. The robot kit is reusable from year-to-year and is programmed using a variety of languages. Teams, including coaches, mentors and volunteers, are required to develop strategy and build robots based on sound engineering principles. Awards are given for the competition as well as for community outreach, design, and other real-world accomplishments.



Books Arrive in Rwanda

Elizabeth Stuhr is a former outbound Rotary exchange student for the 2008-2009 school year. She is now teaching English to middle school students in Rugabano Rwanda, a village with no electricity, as a Peace Corps volunteer. She also leads an English club outside normal school hours to familiarize the students with American culture and customs.

During her last visit to Ankeny, Elizabeth visited Ankeny schools and gave classroom presentations about her work in Rwando. She asked students to donate books for her ship back to Rwanda for her to use in her classes.. The response was so overwhelming that she needed help with the cost to ship the books. The Rotary Club of Ankeny donated \$300 in February, 2014 to ship these books. Elizabeth has forwarded pictures of the new library and says the library is packed every break when it is open and the kids are LOVING the books. She also said "Thanks so much for all our help!"
