The Dictionary Project

A total of 840 dictionaries have been ordered to be distributed by the Rotary Club of Ankeny to Ankeny 4th graders this year. Luke Nelson has volunteered the services of Woodruff Design to print the labels and Damon Miller believes he has some 6th graders to put the labels in the books for us. All we need to do is deliver them during the week of October 21-25. A sign up sheet will be available soon. This will be the 8th consecutive year that our club has participated in this project and our total number of books distributed to Ankeny 4th graders will be 6,000 after this year.

The idea of "The Dictionary Project" began in 1992 when Annie Plummer of Savannah, Georgia, gave 50 dictionaries to children who attended a school close to her home. Each year since then, she has continued to give this gift, raising money to help give more and more books so that in her lifetime she has raised enough money to buy 17,000 dictionaries for children in Savannah. Early on, her project attracted the attention of Bonnie Beeferman of Hilton Head, S.C., who began a project of raising money by selling crafts to buy dictionaries for the school children of Hilton Head and the surrounding communities. By 1995, Bonnie was getting so many requests from local teachers to be included in the project that she wrote a letter to the editor of the Charleston Post and Courier explaining the project and asking for someone to help meet requests from the Charleston area. Mary French, who was already an active school volunteer even though her two children were still of preschool age, read the letter and decided this was a project for her. Starting with a few schools in Charlston and Summerville, she realized quickly that providing dictionaries to all the students in Charlston was going to require serious funding. She and her late husband Arno French formed a 501(c)(3) nonprofit association in 1995 and The Dictionary Project was born.

The original goal was to provide dictionaries to all third-grade students in South Carolina. This was achieved in 1999 but after The Wall Street Journal published a story about the project in 2002, the Dictionary Project took on a national purpose and expanded it's mission to include students in all 50 states. The program has been adopted by many civic organizations including Rotary Clubs. Anyone can participate in this project by sponsoring a program to provide dictionaries to children in their community. The dictionaries are a gift for the children to keep. Since its implementation in 1995, over 20 million children have received dictionaries because thousands of people saw the same need in communities over the United States.



The Tradition of Exchanging Club Banners
