Total income including the sale of tickets and donations was \$8,130. Expenses including prize money and state sales tax was \$2,442.80. This leaves net income of \$5,687.20 which will be split as follows: \$2,824,32 to the Ankeny Service Center, \$1,882.88 to the Rotary Club of Ankeny, \$60 to Kiwanis, \$123 to Lions, \$30 to Ankeny Young Professionals, \$30 to Jaycees, and \$51 to Optimists. Additionally, we've been advised the Jaycees and Ankeny Young Professionals will be donating their share of the proceeds to the Ankeny Service Center.
