#### Polio Plus Night at Iowa Energy Results



The Polio Plus night at the Iowa Energy was held on February 6th. A total of 1,430 tickets were sold by Des Moines area Rotarians. In addition, proceeds from the 50/50 raffle and donations collected totaled \$1,428 which will result in \$12,813 being donated back by the Rotary clubs. This is the highest total in the 8 years this event has been held. Ankeny's share will be approximately \$403

which will be forwarded on to the Rotary Foundation for Polio Plus. Thank you to everyone that purchased tickets.
