#### **Rotary Foundation Minute**



Rotary In the Rotary year of 2014-15 – The Rotary Foundation approved 487 district grants which totaled \$23.8 million. They supported smaller-scale, short-term projects related the Foundation's mission. The Foundation approved 1,078

global grants totaling \$64.9 million dollars. Rotary's global grants support large-scale international activities which are sustainable, and have measurable outcomes that support humanitarian projects, scholarships and vocational training teams. And in 2013-14 \$235 million dollars were distributed through Rotary's the grant process to the world. This is more than the Rockefeller, JB Morgan Chase and the MacArthur Foundations put together!
