Ann Lee Hussey is a member of the Rotary Club of Portland Sunrise in Maine. Sh contracted polio as a 17-month toddler in 1955 and was paralyzed from the wais down. After many surgeries and physical therapy she is able to walk with limitations as an adult. Her husband introduced her to Rotary and she naturally was drawn to support Rotary's polio eradication efforts. She took her first trip international trip to participate in immunization efforts in 2001. What she saw broke her heart and made her even more committed to helping children avoid th

disease.

She has now completed over 20 trips to a number of countries, including Nigeria and other countries where great success has been realized. Her visits include vaccinations as well as efforts to thank the local workers who help Rotarians in their immunizations. She is proud to say that her journey with polio will continue and urges all Rotarians to support the ongoing plan to finally end the threat of the disease.

Board Approves Donation to Cozumel



During the Board meeting on November 12th, a donation request in the amount of \$1,750 for the purchase of three computers for the Jorge, Cozumel, Mexico primary school was approved. The purchase will not only include three Teshiba laptop computers but also Windows, Microsoft office and Geek Squad support, in Spanish, for a year. The computers will be utilizes by approximately 700 children and teachers in the school. Dean and

Gina Lange will carry the computers with them when they return to Cozumel later this month.

Also, the Board decided to table the request for a water filtration system for the school We believe a Rotary International grant cna be obtained which we could combine with our dollars and other participating local clubs to possibly provide filtered water to all the schools on Cozumel not just this one primary school. This will take some time and cooperation from the Rotary Club in Cozumel to explore this possibility.

Rotary Foundation Recognitioin Points



Rotary Contributions to The Rotary Foundation are essential to securing and growing Rotary programs throughout the world. Foundation points are awarded to donors who contribute to The Rotary Foundation

through the Annual Program Fund or PolioPlus. Donors are recognized by being named "Paul Harris Fellows" or "Multiple Paul Harris Fellows" at increments of 1,000 Foundation points. In addition, a donor receives one Foundation "recognition" point for every U.S. dollar contributed. These Foundation points are then available for the Rotarian to gift to a family member, another Rotarian, or non Rotarian.
