Rotary International, in partnership with the Gates Foundation, will spend over \$9 million on childhood health improvements in Nigeria. The continued threat of malaria, pneumonia, and diarrheal diseases to children under five years old in that country has necessitated this action. The project is expected to impact more than 3 million people in over 700,000 households in targeted states.

The Nigeria program is a multi-country initiative aimed at strengthening community health systems and reducing childhood mortality in sub-Saharan Africa especially Nigeria, Mozambique, Zambia, and the Democratic Republic of Congo. The initiative is expected to build on the success of other Rotary programs, which have significantly reduced malaria in targeted districts. Over 2,750 community health workers will be trained and deployed to provide essential diagnoses, treatment, and care for malaria, pneumonia, and diarrhea, significantly reducing childhood mortality in these regions. The program will also foster community engagement and raise awareness on the importance of early disease treatment, while improving data collection and management practices for accurate health reporting and informed decision-making.
