A War Came Into Their Homes



Ukrainian children get a chance to be kids again at a Rotary-funded camp.

Thousands have died and millions have been displaced by the fighting between Russia the Ukraine. Growing up in the shadow of that conflict, many children don't remember a life without war, but Rotary members are giving these children a chance to heal.

The Well-Being for Ukrainian Kids project is held in Poland and includes traditional camp activities along with support from mental health professionals.

The number of Polish Rotary clubs supporting the project is 83, and support has also come from clubs in Sweden and Slovakia.

"We continue this program because we know how these children react, how they change, how they become more open to the world, and how they look at the world the way it should be for a child," says a Polish Rotarian. "War takes from them their childhood. And they still have their children's dreams."
