



Never discount what might grow, big or small try something new this year! **History point -** Rotary helped form United Nations in 1943 due to there was no other organization that had a footstep across the world. So now every November there is a rotary day in honor of this.

Goals to accomplish together-

- 1. D6000 wants to have a first increase of a NET membership overall- Bettendorf goal for membership is: 135 this year, already as of 129 look at what will you to do grow your club is what DG Dave asks
- 2. Reduce the 5-year average of newer members lost. 34% loss over the last 5 years in rotary two years or less. We potentially could be amount the fastest growing district in the US if we make small changes. The club is at 44% over the last 5 years in rotary two years or less. Dg Dave Cook challenged to lower it to 35% this year.
- **3.** Help start 4 new club extensions across the district- DG Dave challenges and asks to look at potential times of another meeting, to help with getting or keep members engaged and join rotary.
- **4.** Generate new service projects based on the interests of club members. Take a meeting to ask what club members want to do. This overall helps engagement and drives club growth and retention.
- **5.** Inspire greater giving to our Foundation- the club does a great job supporting already. DG Dave cook is putting on the magic of giving gala in Nov 15th for a 3-year pledge of \$10,000- the overall goal is to raise \$1 million
- **6.** Attend to Celebrate club stories at District conferences April 12, 2025 in Ankeny

Polio Eradication Update 8/19

Two new Wild Polio cases reported this week. We are now 3 weeks since the Onset of Paralysis of the most recent reported Wild Polio Case in Pakistan.

The Final Two Polio Endemic Countries:
Pakistan Two new Wild Polio cases
reported this week. Fourteen Wild Polio
cases reported in 2024. Six Wild Polio
Cases reported in 2023. The most recent
case had an onset of paralysis on
07/22/24. One WPV1 Sample and no
cVDPV2 Positive Environmental Samples
were reported this week in Pakistan.

Afghanistan No new Wild Polio cases reported this week. Eleven Wild Polio cases reported in 2024. Six Wild Polio Cases reported in 2023. The most recent case had an onset of paralysis on 06/26/24. No WPV1 Samples and no cVDPV2 Positive Environmental Samples were reported this week in Afghanistan.
