News How to Make-Up a Missed Meeting Where to Make-Up a Missed Meeting Next Board Meeting April 9, 2010 Paul Harris Fellows Multiple Paul Harris Fellows The Rotary Foundation Benefactors	END POLIO NOW Polio eradication supporters in the United States and the United Kingdom are texting POLIO to 90999 for a one-time \$5 donation. 222,270,331 children were immunized against polio in 22 countries-17 of them in Africa- during the last 10 days of May in 2009. Rotary and the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation have jointly committed \$555 million for the eradication of polio. The Gates Foundation has contributed a total of \$355 million and Rotary has committed to \$200 million by June 30, 2012. So far \$90 million has been raised in support of Rotary's US\$200 Million Challenge. Polio eradication has been Rotary's top priority since 1985, with more than \$800 million contributed to a global effort that has helped reduce the number of polio cases by 99 percent. "The world would not be where it is without Rotary, and it won't get where it needs to go without Rotary," Gates said.
