FIRST WOMEN INTO THE ROTARY CLUB OF CHARITON

Women were first admitted into the Rotary Club of Chariton in 1988. On June 1, 1988 Shirley Goode became the first female member. Shirley was a member until November of 1990. The next woman to become a member was Karen Holder on July 1, 1988 until June 1994. Ruby Hanson joined on November 1, 1988 until October of 1995. Sharon Kline also became a member on November 1, 1988 until December of 2000. Sharon Kline became the first woman president in 1995-1996.

Currently we have 25 female members & the two longest current members are Kari Lambirth & Jeanne Klaassen. They both joined in 1997.
