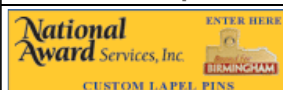

Kent Sovern, Program Speaker Sept. 17

In December 2008, Kent Sovern was named the first Executive Director of the Iowa Parks Foundation. The Foundation was established in April, 2008 by co-chairs, Governor Terry Branstad, Congressman Neal Smith and Joe Crookham who serves as IPF Board President. Mr. Crookham is President of Musco Lighting in Oskaloosa, and is a former member of the National Parks Foundation Board. Joe is a 2008 inductee into the Iowa Business Hall of Fame.

Prior to joining the Iowa Parks Foundation, Kent served as the Executive Director of the Des Moines Higher Education Collaborative, Senior Vice President at the Greater Des Moines Partnership and Director of Public Policy for the League of Iowa Municipalities. Kent is a native of Fort Madison, Iowa and brings over 30 years of management expertise in the fields of organizational development, association management, policy advocacy, k-12 education, local government, business advocacy and higher education to the Foundation.

The Iowa Parks Foundation's mission is to strengthen the connection between Iowa's people and their parks by serving as an independent voice to facilitate a new vision for Iowa's parks, cultivate stewardship through environmental education and research, advocate for adequate funding of park programs and infrastructure improvements, increase the number of park users and improve the quality of visitor experiences in Iowa's parks.

The Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPE) is a model partnership. The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Rotary International, UNICEF, and the World Health Organization (WHO) have been working to support polio-affected countries for more than 20 years.

Each partner plays a particular role, doing what they do best to make an extraordinarily effective whole. Rotary is a powerful fundraiser and advocate. CDC provides technical expertise. UNICEF purchases oral polio vaccine and supports grassroots mobilization, and WHO leads surveillance, operations, and the complicated logistics on the ground.

Bill, Melinda, and I make regular visits to India, one of the four remaining countries where the disease is endemic--and we will continue to do so, to see the progress on the ground and meet with key leaders. In recent years, Bill has also traveled extensively to Nigeria, another endemic country.

The most exciting thing about all the work we're doing together with our partners around the world and in the United States is the tangible difference we can make in the lives of millions and millions of people.
