At the 1917 convention in Atlanta, Arch C. Klumph, then Rotary president, proposed setting up an endowment "for the purpose of doing good in the world." The Rotary Club of Kansas City, Mo., made the first contribution - \$26.50. In 1928, after the endowment fund had grown to more than \$5,000, it was renamed The Rotary Foundation.

In 1929, the Foundation made its first grant - \$500 to the International Society for Crippled Children, as requested by Rotary founder Paul P. Harris.
