Club Administration - Rich Klahn

Club Activities - Jim Pillers - no report

Rotary Foundation - Jim Dobbyn

Jim said that he met with Norlan, Libby and Paul Holmer to discuss Club Points. Jim wants 100% contribution for the past fiscal year (7/1/13 through 6/30/14). He has contacted members that have not contributed during that period to contribute any amount they wish and the club will make a \$1 contribution for members that have not contributed.

Service Project - Amber Wood

Amber said that she, Gary, Norlan and Libby met with Jessica and Tom Krogman on the park projects. She noted that the Emma Young Park has limited equipment and that the zip line cannot be installed there. It will be installed at the Rotary Park and that the club will install sand under the zip line. Amber said that benches have been ordered and that Gary and Tom will meet on when they can be installed. Fall project will be landscaping and installing a retaining wall. She said the committee is ready to focus on the Rainbow Park (need a wheelchair ramp and signage. ADA will review D6000 grant application and write recommendations.

Vocational/International Service - Libby Goodman

Libby said that grant application is in the works. She said that the 100 year committee met and have selected the ball parks for a project. The committee wants to focus on the Riverfront Park and meet with Greg Obren of Parks and Recreations to discuss the project. Norlan suggested to bring CVB in to upgrade fields.
