We had the honor of hearing from Autumn Hinz and Jenny Kennedy about the Clinton area Special Olympics. Hinz has been involved with the Special Olympics for over ten years. The Special Olympics has a huge variety of sports that they offer, including bocce, bowling, swimming, basketball, powerlifting, football, track, and soccer. "Depending on age and disability, we work around that," Hinz explained. "We have one that has severe physical disabilities who power lifted and deadlifted 145 pounds this year when we went to State."

They cover both Clinton and Whiteside Counties and Hinz stated that their goal is to get as many athletes as they can. "We're just trying to get out there and acknowledge as many athletes as possible to allow them to participate and you know hopefully be a little more healthy. Just that mental wellbeing...that 2020 shutdown was not good for any of them. They love socializing and doing this." Hinz discussed the joy that the Special Olympics provides the athletes and that "they are proud to bring home that ribbon or metal."

The athletes can start at age eight unless it's powerlifting, which has an age limit requirement of fourteen years old. Hinz stated that one of the bigger hurdles that they face is funding and transportation. Most of their funding comes from grants and fundraisers. They frequently need volunteers, which range from coaching to chaperoning. Hinz explained that it's really up to the person volunteering as to what they do. For transportation, Hinz and Kennedy explained that they would eventually need a small bus for transporting the athletes to and from the practices and games.
