

FOUNDATION MINUTE

WELCOME TO AUGUST, THE MONTH OF MEMBERSHIP AND NEW **CLUB DEVELOPMENT IN ROTARY!**

BY NOW ROTARY CLUBS ALL OVER THE WORLD ARE SETTLING DOWN TO THEIR NEW SCHEDULE FOR THE NEW ROTARY YEAR. INCLUDING WELCOMING DISTRICT GOVERNORS AND HOSTING DIVERSE GUESTS. AT THE SAME TIME THE ROTARY FOUNDATION IS PLANNING AUTHORIZING GRASSROOT PROJECTS AND DESIGNATING CONTRIBUTIONS THAT SUPPORT FOUNDATION PROGRAMS AND GRANTS.

TRF'S TRUSTEE CHAIR, JOHN GERM, BELIEVES THAT WITH MORE MEMBERS IN ROTARY, "THE FOUNDATION COULD DO EVEN MORE GOOD IN THE WORLD. Dear Polio Eradication Warriors,

No new Wild Polio cases reported this week!

What is that Polio Picture? For nine years, Shumaila Majeed has worked as a community-based health worker in Lahore, with a firm belief in empowering women and supporting their important presence in the polio program.

A Win Against Polio is a Win For Global Health!

That's something to celebrate! It's not yet official, but TRF Trustee Chair John Germ has verbally indicated that we made our 2020-21 \$50 Million PolioPlus Fundraising Goal to be matched by the full \$100 Million from the Gates Foundation! On to the 2021-22 Year!

Pakistan No new Wild Polio cases reported this week. One Wild Polio case reported in 2021. The most recent case had an onset of paralysis on 1/27/21. Pakistan reported 84 Wild Polio cases in 2020. One WPV1 & cVDPV2 Positive Environmental Sample was reported this week in Pakistan.

Afghanistan No new Wild Polio cases reported this week. One Wild Polio

case reported in 2021 The most recent case had an onset of paralysis on 1/01/21. Afghanistan reported 56 Wild Polio cases in 2020. No WPV1 & cVDPV2-Positive Environmental Samples were reported this week in Afghanistan.
