

Our District Governor, Dave Cook, and his wife, Lisa, joined us on Monday and discussed District 6000 and how

the Rotary Club of Clinton can work with the district to achieve their goals.

In 1925, there were already more than fifty Rotary clubs in the state of Iowa, including our very own club! (Go Rotary Club of Clinton!)
"Here's the remarkable thing," began Cook. "Since that time there's over 125 clubs, over 5,000 members but the remarkable thing is this: Every single one of these 50 clubs exists today." Cook explained to us that this is because the communities

support these clubs -- they know the good work they do, so they support our fundraising efforts, our service projects, and more. "There's no better example of the Magic of Rotary. The Magic of Rotary happens at the local, community level."

Cook quoted Stephanie Urchick, the current President of Rotary International and stated, "We are not going to grow membership in polio or bring peace to the World by waving a wand. It's up to you. You create the magic of Rotary with every project completed, every dollar donated, and every new member inducted."

The District Goals for this year are:

- 1. Achieve the first net increase in District 6000 membership in over a decade. (Each club in our district lost an average of 2 members last yr.)
- 2. Reduce the 5 yr average of newer members lost. (Over the past 5 yrs, 34% of members we lost were in Rotary 2 yrs or less.)
- 3. Help start four new club extensions.
- 4. Generate new service project ideas based on interest of the club members.
