Sheriff Bill Greenwalt joined by Clinton County Supervisors Dan Srp and Jim Irwin, along with Chief Deputy Steve Diesch shared with the group the differences from the old and the new jail. The new jail has a place for mental health services, a medical unit with a nurse on staff and more space to house inmates. The old jail was in a condition that required them to have a timeline on replacement or risk being shut down. Sheriff Greenwalt shared that he is grateful for the planning of the new jail and all the well thought out improvements. In the past they could hold only 44 inmates and had to pay to send some to other counties to house them. Now they are able to house inmates from Scott and Johnson as their capacity is 115. The main goal is to reduce recidivism and help them succeed while here so they are better prepared to re-join society. Safety is also a main concern and the building was designed to have limited access to the outside to prevent escapes and minimize injuries to staff. When people are brought to the jail they enter an enclosed garage with access to cells if a person needs to cool down before being processed. Visitors do not enter the jail and speak with loved ones via video phone in the lobby area where cubicles are located on the first floor of the courthouse. We also toured the new 911 center Donations to the Foundation: and the control tower on a raised design that views all the different pods and features 135 cameras. Rotary members also toured the kitchen, recreation space and classroom. Classes are conduction by Clinton Community College including the High School Equivalency Test (HISET) program.
