BECCA EASTMAN

This Monday, we heard from Becca Eastman, from the Iowa Reading Corps. Launched in 2013, Iowa Reading Corps supports kindergarten through third-grade students in school districts across the state. Since then, we've helped more than 13,800 local students get on track to succeed! The program is a replication of the successful Minnesota model and is operated by local United Ways.

Eastman explained that they operate through a Federal branch of AmeriCorps. "What I do is I recruit schools as well as members to come on board as Iowa Reading Corps tutors. We recruit, train, and support them as well as pay them. We call them paid volunteers and they serve anywhere between 18 and 25 hours a week the entire school year working with kindergarten through third-grade students," explained Eastman. These students receive "high dosage" tutoring, which is five days a week, twenty minutes a day of tutoring. This model is all research and evidence-based and data-driven.

This program is serving in sixteen states and they tutor more than 50,000 students annually for reading. This is supplemental programming, meaning it enhances and does not replace the high-quality Core Curriculum that's taking place within the schools. Any student that is below the targeted goal is eligible for this one-on-one tutoring. "Research has shown that we can help a student grow 50 to 90% of a school year so we really are filling in those gaps and post-COVID, this has really become more and more relevant," stated Eastman.

Presidential Project Food Security Summit - March 2025

Goals:

- Local Initiative:
 - Host a strategic planning session for Clinton, Iowa's social agencies to address food security with county-wide participation.
 - o Engage a professional facilitator to create a plan for sustainable solutions.
 - Rotary Club of Clinton acts as a catalyst for collaboration and resource sharing, funded by the Rotary Foundation.
- Awareness Campaign:
 - Produce videos showcasing Rotary's role as a convener and problem solver.
 - Highlight the club's efforts to address food insecurity and share results to inspire community support.
 - Participating agencies will have access to these materials to help support their missions.

Key Elements
