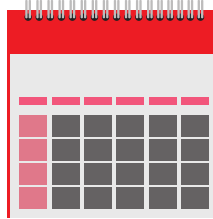

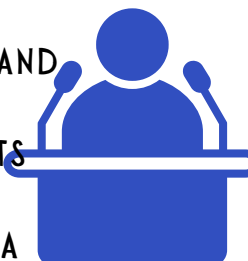

FOUNDATION MINUTE

WELCOME TO THE LAST WEEK OF NOVEMBER, RI'S
FOUNDATION MONTH.

HOPE YOU ALL HAD A WONDERFUL THANKSGIVING DAY. AS 2021 RUSHES TO WELCOME THE NEW YEAR, IT'S IMPORTANT FOR ROTARIANS TO STOP FOR A MOMENT AND REMIND OURSELVES OF HOW TRF HAS KEPT UP ITS IMPRESSIVE RECORD WITH GRANTS THROUGHOUT THIS YEAR.

A QUICK BREAKDOWN REVEALS THE FOLLOWING:

1. 1,359 GLOBAL GRANTS FOR A SUM OF	\$ 95.6M
2. 490 DISTRICT GRANTS TOTALING	\$ 33.6 M
3. 339 DISASTER RESPONSE GRANTS	\$ 8.4M

TOTAL - APPROX. \$138 MILLION

A FURTHER BREAKDOWN SHOWS HOW THE GLOBAL GRANTS WERE DISTRIBUTED ACROSS THE FORMER 6 AREAS OF FOCUS:

TRF SPENDING:

FIGHTING DISEASE	\$73.0M
CLEAN WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE	\$19.0M
GROWING LOCAL ECONOMY	\$17.1M
EDUCATION	\$11.4M
SAVING MOTHERS AND CHILDREN	\$10.9M
PROMOTING PEACE	\$ 6.6M
TOTAL - APPROX.	\$138 MILLION
