Kirby Winn

Kirby Winn, Public Relations with Impact Life, joined us on Monday to discuss all that Impact Life does and the importance of Blood donation. Formerly known as the Mississippi Valley Regional Blood Center, Impact Life came to be in 2021, after expanding areas and merging with two other blood centers in the last ten years. Impact Life serves 124 hospitals and emergency service providers in Illinois, Iowa, Missouri, and Wisconsin. They collect over 222,000 units from volunteer blood donors at 5,000+ mobile drives and 22 Donor Centers. Additionally, they are the provider of all blood components to MercyOne Clinton Medical Center.

Donor Recruitment consists of communication tools, such as emails, calls, and text messages, donor promotions (gift card programs, Donor for Life rewards), posters, signs, and banners, and donor records and scheduling systems. Winn commented that often donations tamper off over the holidays, yet the need for blood remains the same. Blood providers have joined forces to prepare for mass transfusion disasters, ensuring our ability to meet blood needs without delay! This is called BERC (Blood Emergency Readiness Corps).


