

The Downtown Clinton Alliance (DCA) came and spoke with our club on Monday and provided us with wonderful updates for the area. Kari White is the President of Downtown Clinton Alliance and owner of Happy Joes Pizza, Lindsay Morhardt is the owner of the Rusty Barell and a Board Member of DCA, and Megan Dove, with Three Dove Designs, is the administrator for DCA. Both White and Dove are friends of Rotary and have presented to us before!

"'What are we up to?' We kind of go by 'Clean, Safe, Beautiful' and then everything that we do and focus on falls within those topics," explained Dove. Some of their projects include:

- City: Downtown traffic light changes
- Working with the City to upgrade Lighting on 5th Ave. S. & 6th Ave. S. and additional safety initiatives.
- Partnering with Grow Clinton to address safety concerns with CPD and the Downtown
- Efforts to revitalize the landscaping in the Downtown.

White discussed Music on the Avenue, which they're revitalizing and making better than ever. Music on the Avenue saw record numbers last year and they're about 98% finished

picking bands. They are doing ten weeks in 2025 and it will be 2.5 hours long each night. White told us, "It just wasn't long enough. We have people who want to talk and everybody just wants to stay out and have fun. This is one of the few things in our community that's free -- one of the few things probably in our world that's free — and we want to keep it that way. We do have sponsorships available



if you or business is interested in sponsoring Music on the Avenue, please get a hold of one of us we would be glad to talk to you." Other events coming include an adult prom, Fall Haunted Wine & Beer Walk and more!

### Presidential Project Food Security Summit - March 2025

#### Goals:

- Local Initiative:
  - Host a strategic planning session for Clinton, Iowa's social agencies to address food security with county-wide participation.
  - Engage a professional facilitator to create a plan for sustainable solutions.
  - Rotary Club of Clinton acts as a catalyst for collaboration and resource sharing, funded by the Rotary Foundation.
- Awareness Campaign:
  - Produce videos showcasing Rotary's role as a convener and problem solver.
  - Highlight the club's efforts to address food insecurity and share results to inspire community support.
  - Participating agencies will have access to these materials to help support their missions.

### **Key Elements**

- Global Impact: Since 2019, Rotary Club of Clinton has supported sustainable gardening and water management in Oaxaca, connecting clubs internationally to tackle humanitarian issues.
- Local Collaboration: The club will unify Clinton's social agencies to address food insecurity and amplify local efforts through collaboration.
- **Storytelling:** Professionally produced videos will promote awareness of Rotary's global and local impact, fostering support for initiatives.

Club President Carrie Donaire draws on her Peace Corps experience in food security and agriculture in Nicaragua to inform her vision, emphasizing both global and local solutions.
