
Janet & Fred Young

Watch our Meeting HERE

Last week, we had the pleasure of hearing from Fred and Janet Young, who were both victims of the 2016 Brussels Airport Bombings. On March 22, 2016, two suicide bombers, carrying explosives in large suitcases, attacked the departure hall at Brussels Airport in Zaventem. The first explosion occurred at 07:58 in checkin row 11; the second explosion occurred about nine seconds later in check-in row 2. The suicide bombers were visible in CCTV footage. A third suicide bomber left the airport without detonating his bomb, which was later found in a search of the airport and destroyed by a controlled explosion. The bombing took thirty-two lives, excluding the three suicide bombers, and injured over 300 people. The bombings were the deadliest attack on Belgium since World War II. Nine people were sentenced for responsibility for the attacks.

Janet and Fred both turned towards God in the moments after the bombs went off, both calling out to God and realizing His love and strength. Janet stated numerous times, "God is Good." When asked if Fred felt vengeance, he stated, "We can trust Him for vengeance he says vengeance is mine, so we can release that to him and work with our own forgiveness and not feel the feelings of vengeance and retribution. We trust God's going to take care of that and He's the ultimate justice for us." Janet continued this thought and stated,

"There is no perfect iustice. The human system is not perfect because we're all so imperfect you know... I think we did choose to move on by letting God deal with it and I think that it's helping us find Joy again."

Althea Cahoy, Executive Director of the River Bluff Community Foundation joined us this week and talked to us about what the Foundation does. Founded in 2005, the Foundation had the vision to be sure that our community's charitable needs were met. Their main goals are to support our community, build a brighter future, and position donors to make a difference in our community.

The Community Foundation of Greater Dubuque consists of a seven-county region, where the mission is to strengthen communities and inspire giving. Their vision is also inspiring, with a focus on creating a community where everyone can thrive. Their values are equity and opportunity, collaboration, stewardship, and knowledge. Cahoy stated, "Our affiliation with the Community Foundation of Greater Dubuque provides four main things for us. They provide back-office support...They provide educational opportunities for us....The last thing they also help to ensure that all the money that is given to all of the nonprofits with us stays local. That money stays in Clinton. That's an important thing that they do -- all donations to River Bluff and our family of funds stay right in Clinton and Camanche. This support that they provide for us really helps my board and myself be the boots on the street and focus on doing the work of our mission so we are very grateful for what they have done for us."

"Energize Clinton, Powered by Community Heart and Soul" is a pilot program that is the first of its kind and the first in the nation. It takes two phases, or initiatives, -- Phase 1: Community Heart and Soul and Phase 2: Small Town Dreams -- to create one program. Cahoy stated, "In Phase one, we learned about what residents value most -- their hopes for the future and what kind of projects we can do to make Clinton an even better place to live, work, and play. Then we'll move into phase two, the small-town dreams, where we will create a funding source to support projects and ideas that matter most to the residents of Clinton."
