

Andrew Naeve of Naeve Family Beef spoke to our club this week. The Naeve family has been doing this for six generations and they're quite proud of their ability to grow high-quality cattle, and it has been a longawaited dream to take the step further to create their own brand of beef. It's taken them over 125 years to develop our land stewardship and animal husbandry practices and we are committed to continuously evolving. Construction for their new facility began in June 2021, with the initial belief that it would take about eight to ten months, but it took a little longer. Naeve Family Beef had its official ribbon cutting (pictured) on March 5, 2022. Their first harvest of an animal took place on June 2, 2022. Their average harvest is around average around 60 heads per day.



They went for a very strict food safety audit, called the BRC Global Standard, and are now certified with that, in just five months. Naeve said there are plants out there that have been going for over five years that still haven't gotten this certification, which he credits to his awesome team. This certification allows them to sell to high-end retailers and restaurants. Naeve Beef employs around 70 people.

Very soon, Naeve Family Beef's website (https://naevefamilybeef.com) will allow them to do nationwide shipping on all of their products, including individual products and bundles! One day of the week, they will do local, one-day delivery, when you spend over a specific amount. Their website will also have seasonal bundles available and subscription box options!

WELCOME TO WEEK THREE OF RI'S MONTH OF PEACE & CONFLICT RESOLUTION

AS OF MIDNIGHT ON SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 11, 2023, THE PROJECTED CASUALTIES OF THE DEVASTATING EARTHQUAKE THAT HIT TURKEY AND SYRIA HAD RISEN TO OVER 30,000 MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN DEAD. ADDITIONALLY, MILLIONS HAVE BEEN RENDERED HOMELESS IN THE BITTERLY FRIGID WINTER WEATHER. THE ROTARY WORLD RESPONDED TO THIS CATASTROPHE IMMEDIATELY. ACCORDING TO RI'S WEBSITE, PRESIDENT JENNIFER JONES ACTIVATED OUR DISASTER RESPONSE EFFORTS, COMMUNICATED WITH THE AFFECTED DISTRICTS, AND ENCOURAGED GOVERNORS IN THOSE REGIONS TO APPLY FOR DISASTER RESPONSE GRANTS AND SHARE INFORMATION ABOUT THEIR RELIEF EFFORTS SO THAT ROTARY CAN AMPLIFY THE CALLS FOR SUPPORT.
