



We had the absolute privilege of meeting Theresa Greenfield this week. Greenfield is the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development State Director in Iowa. She was appointed Director by President Biden in 202. The USDA Rural Development supports rural prosperity by providing loans, loan guarantees, and grants for community facilities, business programs, and rural housing. There are over 70 programs, some of which began in 1862, when the Department of Agriculture was founded. In the 1930s, during the Dust Bowl, the government ensured the American people had a strong food system. Greenfield discussed some of the Biden administration's priorities for rural communities. "Since day one of the Biden Administration, President Biden and Secretary Vilsack have been committed to making historic investments in Rural America. They believe it is the backbone of our country's economy and we

certainly know it is the backbone of Iowa's economy... The Inflation Reduction Act was passed, which was a historical investment into taking climate action in our agriculture systems..they also passed \$2.5 billion Bipartisan Infrastructure Law and \$436 million for high-speed Internet."


