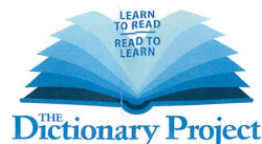

IN FACT, 1 IN 3 PEOPLE THAT REACH AGE 65 WILL DIE FROM SOME FORM OF DEMENTIA."

THERE ARE ROUGHLY 50 MILLION PEOPLE LIVING ON THE PLANET THAT ARE LIVING WITH ALZHEIMER'S RIGHT NOW. LANE POINTED OUT THAT WHILE THIS IS A DEVASTATING DISEASE, THERE ARE SILVER LININGS. 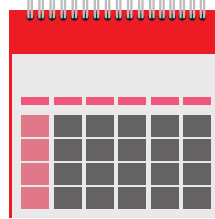
