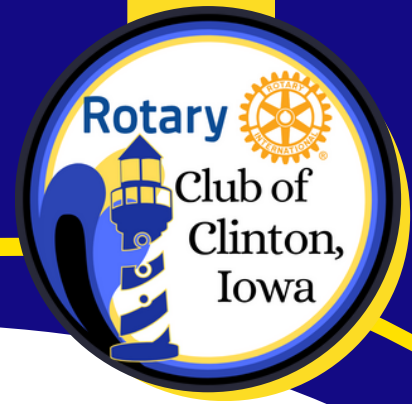

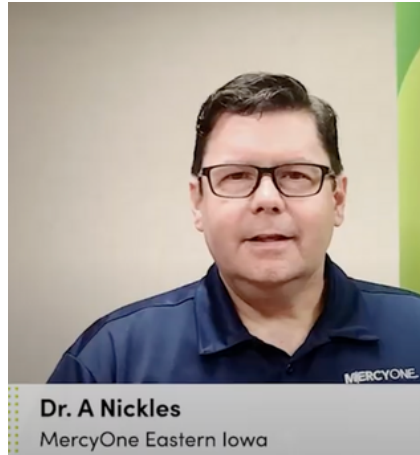

MERCYONE.

CALL TO SCHEDULE

We had the pleasure of hearing from Melissa Wood, the COO of MercyOne and Dr. Ashton Nickels, Chief Medical Officer with MercyOne.

MercyOne has statewide coverage throughout Iowa and has 4.1 million patient visits annually, with over 300 care locations, 22 owned hospitals, and 24 affiliated hospitals. There are more than 22,700 workers, with 2,750 Physicians and Clinicians. Dr. Nickels talked about the changes in staffing and the openings that they have available, which include Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Anesthesia, and Family Medicine OB/GYN. Dr. Alex Sieg (Medical Oncology) and Katherine Fitzpatrick, ARNP Oncology will both be coming in August 2024. Dr. Nickels talked about the partnerships that have been explained, including ORA Partnership, Radiology Group, Pathology Group, and General Surgery.

"If you need a doctor and you can't find one and you don't like to wait on hold, call 421 DOCS," expressed Dr. Nickels. "You can schedule your own appointments, so you can go in when it's convenient for you and you can see just what times are available so we're really trying to make access to care easier, more available, and find of course more physicians." Wood also commented that they have "24/7 coverage" for general surgery thanks to the partnership with Genesis.

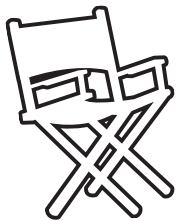
