

Mayor Scott Maddasion

We had the pleasure of hearing from our Mayor, Scott Maddasion, on Monday as he discussed this year's Tailgate & Tallboys. This is the second year of a set of concerts that the city contracted with USA Concerts, out of Peoria. Maddasion stated, "From year one to year two we did see a lot of growth in many avenues and that's what we're looking for...You kind of look at this as starting a new business when you start a festival. Yes they have their brand, and they did it in other places, but each market is different so you're starting a new business, so we're learning as we go and we're making changes that are trying to make it better for the concert-goer we're trying to make changes anywhere we can where we can work on the revenue side because obviously, that's an important piece, just like when you're doing with any business."

"If you look at sales by zip code, we had 44 states and Canada," expressed Maddasion. On Thursday, they had 12,500 attendees, on Friday 10,500, and 13,000 for Saturday, "so our attendance was up pretty close to 9 to 10,000 people over the weekend this year. The difference from last year to this year though -- one thing that we noticed on Jelly Roll day, it was pretty comparable to what he did on Saturday the year before. Our Friday and Saturday this year we noticed that people came later in the day." Overall, Maddasion stated that they increased their attendance, which was due to increased ticket sales and sponsorships.

Finally, Maddasion told us that we had zero arrests and only a few medical issues this year. Thank you for talking with us about the success of Tailgate & Tallboys, Mayor Scott! We look forward to next year's event!
