

NO NEW WILD POLIO CASES REPORTED THIS WEEK!

WHAT IS THAT POLIO PICTURE? THIS WEEK'S PICTURE SHOWS POLIO SURVEILLANCE ACTIVITIES IN MOGADISHU, SOMALIA. SURVEILLANCE IS CRITICAL TO ASSURE THE ERADICATION OF THE POLIOVIRUS IN A COMMUNITY.
