Chris Streets joined on Monday and discussed the Clinton Area Showboat Theatre. Streets has spoken with our club many times and we're certainly no stranger to his voice, as he's the Disc Jokey for MAC 94.7 FM. Streets is the Board President for the Clinton Area Showboat Theatre. The Clinton Area Showboat Theatre produces professional summer theatre and theatre education programs that contribute to the cultural and artistic climate of the greater Clinton Area communities.

The process to get a show is not for the faint of heart. The Board's Artistic Director puts out ideas for shows, which has to be agreed upon by the rest of the board. "If we do like it, we begin calling all of the different royalty companies to see if we can afford to do the shows, because each show has a different price. They want to know how many people you're going to put in the theater, how many performances you're going to do, of course, and then they tell you what it's going to cost you," explained Streets. Once that's finished, the 'cattle call' is put out for auditions to cast the show. From there, the Board of Directors start working on housing, which tends to be the most challenging aspect of the whole process, planning with the City, cleaning the Showboat, and more. All of that work and more is what creates an amazing season for the Showboat. Streets expressed his desire to see all of us at one or many of the shows this season. Purchase vour tickets today!
