
Jenna Stevens

Jenna Stevens from Preston, Iowa, is currently the Ag in the Classroom Consultant for Clinton and Jackson Counties. In that role, she gives students exposure to agricultural experiences through hands-on learning opportunities. Additionally, she runs the CAC Media Group, which comprises current high school and college students interested in agricultural communications. While the group has shared many stories of agriculture over the years, its primary focus today is on the sport of bull riding. Stevens joined us about a year ago, talking about the students' journeys to becoming published authors, and this week, she shared with us more on that journey and brought the published children's book, "Buckin' Bull Buddies."

Stevens explained, "We used to work a lot on the livestock show side of things and on the livestock industry side of things; however, back in 2018, we had the opportunity to go to Las Vegas and do some work with the Professional Bull Riders or the PBR Association. From there, we had a chance to go to Fort Worth when the National Finals Rodeo was held down there. We did coverage at the rodeo and got involved in the junior side of bull riding, and

kind of have never looked back!" The team writes for and helps manage HNH Bull Riding Magazine in Fort Worth, where they oversee the junior and college sections of the publication.

Recently, one of Stevens' students, Katlin Truelsen, published her first children's book about bull riding. Stevens told us about the experience and the learning opportunities that Katlin went through while writing the book. The book revolves around two childhood best friends who are bull riders and the lessons they learned along the way.
