WELCOME TO WEEK 3 OF ROTARY INTERNATIONAL'S FELLOWSHIP MONTH.

HAPPY FATHER'S DAY TO ALL ROTARIANS AND OTHER FATHERS AROUND THE WORLD.

IT'S BEEN A VERY BUSY WEEK FOR ROTARIANS ALL OVER THE WORLD, ESPECIALLY AS CLUBS AND DISTRICTS PREPARE FOR A NEW ROTARY SERVICE YEAR. NEW PRESIDENTS, SECRETARIES AND BOARD MEMBERS ARE BEING SWORN IN AND ATTEMPTS ARE BEING MADE TO KEEP THE 4-WAY TEST RELEVANT. IN THE MIDST OF ALL THESE, TRF KEEPS ON DOING GOOD GLOBALLY, EQUIPPING MEDICAL CLINICS AND CENTERS WITH LIFE-SAVING EQUIPMENT, DONATING RELIEF MATERIALS TO VICTIMS OF NATURAL DISASTERS AND AS RECENTLY AS FEW DAYS AGO, IMPROVING THE PERSONAL HYGIENE OF TEENAGERS. THE ROTARY CLUB OF HAENERTSBURG, SOUTH AFRICA, WITH THE HELP OF A ROTARY FOUNDATION GLOBAL GRANT CAME TO THE AID OF SCHOOLGIRLS IN RURAL LIMPOPO BY INTRODUCING THEM TO REUSABLE SANITARY KITS. THE R1.78 MILLION (124,000 USD) GRANT WILL TRAIN 25 CANDIDATES IN FABRIC DESIGN AS WELL AS ENTREPRENEURIAL SKILLS FROM THE JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT CURRICULUM.

NO NEW WILD POLIO CASES REPORTED THIS WEEK!

STARTING NEXT WEEK, I WILL INCLUDE ONE OF THE COMPREHENSIVE LIST OF ACTIONS EACH WEEK WHICH WILL POSITION US TO ACHIEVE A POLIO-FREE WORLD.

A WIN AGAINST POLIO IS A WIN FOR GLOBAL HEALTH!

• 6/17/21 THE GPEI IS DEEPLY SADDENED BY THE REPORTS OF 5 SEPARATE ATTACKS ON HEALTH WORKERS IN AFGHANISTAN IN WHICH 5 WERE KILLED AND 4 WERE INJURED TODAY. WE WISH TO EXTEND OUR DEEPEST CONDOLENCES TO THE FAMILIES, RELATIVES AND COLLEAGUES OF THE VICTIMS. THESE INCIDENTS ARE A SOMBER REMINDER OF THE DIFFICULT AND OFTEN DANGEROUS ENVIRONMENTS HEALTH WORKERS OPERATE IN. HEALTH WORKERS MUST NEVER BE A TARGET AND ANY ATTACK ON HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS REMAINS COMPLETELY UNACCEPTABLE. ALL PARTIES MUST RESPECT AND UPHOLD THE NEUTRALITY OF HEALTH INTERVENTIONS AND ENSURE THE SAFETY OF ALL HEALTH WORKERS, WHO ARE WORKING ACROSS THE COUNTRY TO PREVENT DISEASE AND IMPROVE THE HEALTH OF COMMUNITIES.

- PAKISTAN NO NEW WILD POLIO CASES REPORTED THIS WEEK. ONE WILD POLIO CASE REPORTED IN 2021. THE MOST RECENT CASE HAD AN ONSET OF PARALYSIS ON 1/27/21. PAKISTAN REPORTED 84 WILD POLIO CASES IN 2020. NO WPV1 & CVDPV2 POSITIVE ENVIRONMENTAL SAMPLES WERE REPORTED THIS WEEK IN PAKISTAN.
- AFGHANISTAN NO NEW WILD POLIO CASES REPORTED THIS WEEK. ONE WILD POLIO CASE REPORTED IN 2021 THE MOST RECENT CASE HAD AN ONSET OF PARALYSIS ON 1/01/21. AFGHANISTAN REPORTED 56 WILD POLIO CASES IN 2020. NO WPV1 & CVDPV2-POSITIVE ENVIRONMENTAL SAMPLES WERE REPORTED THIS WEEK IN AFGHANISTAN.
