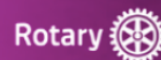

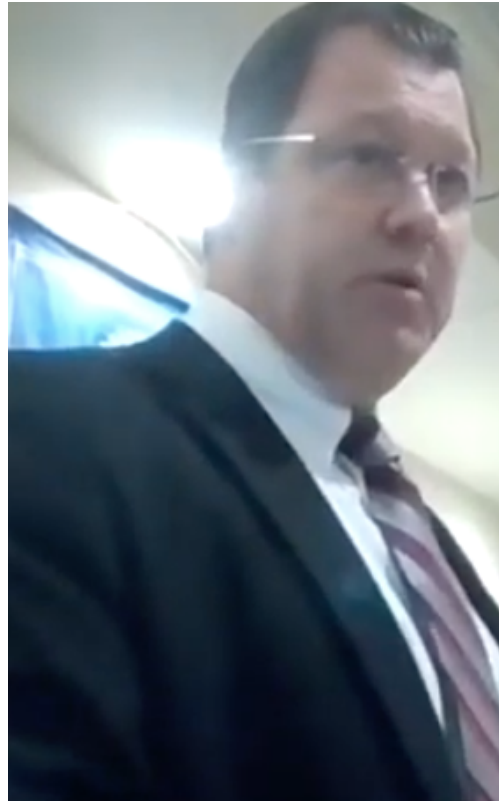

SHEILA TJADEN FROM THE RIVER BLUFF COMMUNITY FOUNDATION SPOKE WITH US ON MONDAY ABOUT THE WONDERFUL THINGS THAT THE FOUNDATION DOES. "THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION REALLY DOES THREE THINGS -- WE WORK WITH PHILANTHROPIC PEOPLE TO SUPPORT CAUSES THAT THEY CARE ABOUT...WE ALSO STRENGTHEN THOSE NONPROFITS AND WE ALSO SUPPORT COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP." TODD WENT ON TO TELL US THAT A FEW YEARS AGO, THERE WAS A STUDY DONE BY IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY WHERE THEY DETERMINED THAT IN CLINTON COUNTY, OVER THE NEXT 30 YEARS, THERE WILL BE ABOUT \$9.3 BILLION DOLLARS TRANSFERRED FROM ONE GENERATION TO THE NEXT. "IF 5% OF THAT 9.3 BILLION COULD BE TRANSFERRED AND SECURED INTO ENDOWMENTS, THAT WOULD BE \$463 MILLION...THAT TRANSLATES INTO \$19 MILLION DOLLARS THAT WOULD BE ALLOCATED TO YOUR COMMUNITY THROUGH THOSE ENDOWMENT FUNDS EACH YEAR." TODD CONTINUED TO TELL US THAT RIVER BLUFF COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OFFERS TRAINING AND RESOURCES FOR THEIR NONPROFITS -- INCLUDING STRATEGIC PLANNING. RIVER BLUFF IS JUST OVER 1 MILLION IN ASSETS. THEY'RE WORKING ON SUSTAINABILITY AND OPERATIONS WITH A NEW DIRECTOR. THANK YOU, SHEILA, FOR TAKING TIME TO TALK TO OUR CLUB!

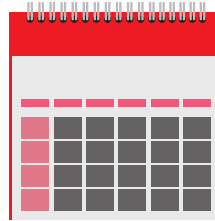

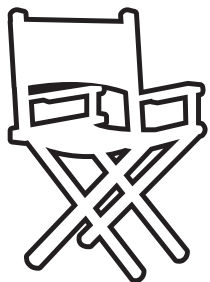

WELCOME ROTARIANS TO WEEK 4 OF ROTARY'S MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH MONTH!

ALLISON POTTER, A DOUBLE MAJOR (PUBLIC HEALTH STUDIES/POLICY STUDIES) GRADUATING SENIOR FROM ELON UNIVERSITY IN ELON, NORTH CAROLINA HAS BEEN AWARDED THE ROTARY FOUNDATION GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP, A PRESTIGIOUS AWARD THAT WILL SUPPORT HER PURSUIT OF A MASTER'S DEGREE AT THE LONDON SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS AFTER GRADUATING FROM ELON IN MAY. POTTER RECEIVED THE SCHOLARSHIP FROM THE PIEDMONT DISTRICT 7690 ROTARY CLUB. THE 2022 RF GLOBAL SCHOLAR HOPES TO WORK IN GLOBAL HEALTH, CONSULTING ON PROGRAM MONITORING AND EVALUATION; OR IN REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT BEFORE PURSUING HER DOCTORATE AND WORKING IN AN ACADEMIC SETTING. "THIS OPPORTUNITY WILL HELP ME GROW IN CULTURAL HUMILITY AND INDEPENDENCE AS I NAVIGATE LIVING AND LEARNING ACROSS DIFFERENCES," POTTER SAID. "LEAVING ELON, MOVING ABROAD AND PURSUING GRADUATE SCHOOL WILL NOT BE EASY, HOWEVER, IT WILL BE AN AMAZING ADVENTURE AND WILL PREPARE ME WELL FOR THE FUTURE," POTTER SAID. SHE EXPRESSED IMMENSE GRATITUDE TO THE DEDICATED MEMBERS OF DISTRICT 7690 ROTARY CLUB, WHO WILL HELP HER EARN HER MASTER'S DEGREE IN LONDON "WHERE I WILL BE ABLE TO PURSUE A GLOBAL EDUCATION TO MATCH MY GLOBAL CAREER GOALS."
