

**Sheriff Bill Greenwalt** 

During our last Rotary meeting, Sheriff Bill Greenwalt joined us and discussed the changes that have happened in the last year with the Sheriff department and Clinton County. Greenwalt is no stranger to our club, as a former Rotarian and a presenter. Greenwalt has been in law enforcement for over thirty years.

Sherrif Greenwalt talked about some of the positive and negative things he has seen on the job. One positive that Greenwalt and other agencies worked together to bring is the Resource Center, which is designed to help people who have been incarcerated get back on their feet when released. Another positive was appointing Steve Diesch as his Chief Deputy, which is who Greenwalt ran against. Greenwalt shared with us that this was one of his best decisions. "Honestly, where his strong suit was, maybe was my not such strong suit and together, we've made a great team over the last six years."

A frustration Sheriff Greenwalt talked about is the negativity that brews in the community and on social media about Clinton and the surrounding areas. "We have such a great community," Greenwalt explained. "You know what? We have a safe community...I think one of the best parts of my job is I've been paid to drive around and look at every part of this community -- the first thirty years was strictly in the city of Clinton and the last six have been in the entire county. And boy, I'll tell you we should be thankful for what we have."

One thing Sheriff Greenwalt discussed with us was regarding mental health and substance abuse. Sheriff Greenwalt talked about how devastating it feels to respond to a call numerous times about a person who is obviously experiencing a mental health crisis, only to have to deliver a death notice to their family after months of trying to get them help. Unfortunately, the program that helped get mental health advocates riding in the squad cars had to end due to budget constraints, which Greenwalt said he hopes they rethink losing that money. "That was probably the best thing that we've done as a community for mental health in a long time." Greenwalt also explained that without the mental health advocates deescalating the situation, "Now mental health just turned into a crime," as people who are in a mental health crisis often are thinking they need to fight the police who show up to help.

Thank you, Sheriff Greenwalt, for all of your dedication to Clinton County!
