Fidel Henderson from Victory Center Ministries (VCM) joined us on Monday and discussed "Victory Center 2.0." Victory Center 2.0 is an enhanced nine-month recovery program, which includes a robust career development curriculum, case management and counseling services, and essential life skills coaching and training. Victory Center 2.0 focused more on the choice of engaging in religious activities, while VCM operates as a faith-based organization, all services funded by government grants will be delivered on a non-religious basis, with participation in religious activities now entirely voluntary.

Henderson, who is fellow Rotarian Ray Gimenez's partner in both VCM and the Victory Center 2.0 discussed these changes, which includes changes in the bylaws and funding. Henderson stated, "Victory Center as a whole has decided to make this new change that is very important in terms of how we're going to help people that didn't want to be able to come into the program because of the religious aspect of the program." Henderson stated they're starting small with six beds. For thirty days, you can use their shelter with no mandates whatsoever. Their hope is that the person will use it and use their time wisely, to help get themselves back on their feet. If they want to go into the spiritual program, they do have that choice.

VCM is only donor funded, period. Pastor Ray has "elected to cut the federal funding of any sort because a lot of times the funding came with red tape. And then in the current bylaws, there was the conflict of interest, obviously with the religious aspect of it. So pastor Ray said, 'No I'm not going to that's not going to take any federal funds.'" These changes are in attempts to be more effective in the community and to reflect VCM's ongoing commitment to empowering individuals through comprehensive support while maintaining its mission of compassion and service. This shift ensures greater inclusivity and accessibility for all individuals seeking support, aligning with VCM's values of respect and dignity for every person.
