<u>WATCH OUR</u> <u>MEETING</u> <u>HERE</u>

THIS PAST MONDAY, OUR ROTARY CLUB HAD THE DELIGHT TO MEET DEPUTY CHIEF OF POLICE, JAMES BALLAUER. BALLAUER, WHO IS ORIGINALLY FROM CHICAGO, LIVED IN LAS VEGAS FOR A WHILE, DOING SECURITY FOR CONCERTS, THEN SPENT 23 YEARS WITH THE CHICAGO POLICE. BALLAUER WAS ALSO ABLE TO WORK SECURITY FOR THE CHICAGO WHITE SOX, FROM 2000-2016, WHERE HE SAW A LOT OF FUN AND EXCITING THINGS, INCLUDING THE 2005 WORLD SERIES, WHERE THE WHITE SOX DOMINATED AGAINST THE HOUSTON ASTROS. AFTER WORKING IN THE CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT, BALLAUER WAS HIRED AS DEPUTY CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY OF CLINTON IN MARCH 2021.

BALLAUER STATED THAT KEEPING UP WITH TECHNOLOGY IS A PRIORITY FOR THE CLINTON POLICE DEPARTMENT. CPD HAS WORKED ON THIS PRIORITY BY PUTTING A KIOSK IN THE LOBBY, FOR CITIZENS TO BE ABLE TO FILE A REPORT QUICKLY. ADDITIONALLY, BODY-WORN CAMERAS ON THE OFFICERS HAVE IMPROVED OFFICERS' SAFETY AND EVIDENCE QUALITY, WHILE REDUCING CIVILIAN COMPLAINTS. THESE CAMERAS IS ESPECIALLY HELPFUL, AS SERGEANTS NOW DO "RANDOM BODY CAMERA REVIEW," WHERE THEY REVIEW RANDOM CAMERA FOOTAGE FROM AN OFFICER FOR BOTH GOOD AND BAD PROCEDURES.

BALLAUER ALSO TALKED TO US ABOUT THE CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM, WHERE MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS HAVE TEAMED UP WITH THE CPD OFFICERS AND GO ON CALLS WITH THE OFFICERS. IN 2021, CPD HAD 36,149 INTERACTIONS WITH THE PUBLIC. OF THOSE INTERACTIONS, ONLY NINE OF THEM REQUIRED THE USE OF PHYSICAL FORCE (ANYTHING OUTSIDE OF PUTTING HANDCUFFS ON SOMEONE). BALLAUER ALSO STATED THAT IN 2021, THEY HAD 1274 ARRESTS. BALLAUER CONCLUDED BY REMINDING EVERYONE *NOT* TO LEAVE THEIR CAR RUNNING WITH THE KEYS INSIDE! FOUNDATION MINUTE

WELCOME TO WEEK 4 OF RI'S MONTH OF BASIC EDUCATION & LITERACY

IN RESPONSE TO ROTARY INTERNATIONAL'S FOCUS ON INCREASING ITS IMPACT, AND MOBILIZING NETWORKS IN ORDER TO CREATE LASTING SOLUTIONS, TRF CREATED PROGRAMS OF SCALE TO SUPPORT ROTARY MEMBER-LED, EVIDENCE-BASED PROGRAMS WITH DEMONSTRATED SUCCESS.

EACH YEAR, PROGRAMS OF SCALE WILL SUPPORT A COMPETITIVE GRANT PROCESS RESULTING IN ONE AWARD OF US\$2 MILLION FROM TRF THAT IS DISTRIBUTED OVER A THREE-TO FIVE-YEAR PERIOD TO A CLUB -OR DISTRICT-SPONSORED PROGRAM SHOWING SUCCESS AND READINESS TO EXPAND TO HELP MORE PEOPLE IN MORE PLACES. TRF \$2,000,000 PROGRAMS OF SCALE RECIPIENT FOR THIS YEAR, IS THE TOGETHER FOR HEALTHY FAMILIES IN NIGERIA. AIMED AT REDUCING THE MATERNAL AND NEONATAL MORTALITY RATES IN FOUR NIGERIAN STATES BY 25%. THE GRANT IS A COLLABORATION OF THE FOLLOWING ENTITIES: ROTARY DISTRICTS 1860 (GERMANY); 9110, 9125, 9141 AND 9142 (NIGERIA): THE ROTARY ACTION GROUP FOR REPRODUCTIVE, MATERNAL AND CHILD HEALTH; NIGERIAN FEDERAL AND STATE MINISTRIES OF HEALTH; MEDICAL ASSOCIATIONS AND COMMUNITY LEADERS.

THE \$2 MILLION GRANT WILL ENABLE THE PROGRAM TO PROVIDE EDUCATION AND TRAINING FOR QUALITY CARE, KNOWLEDGE OF HEALTHY TIMING AND SPACING OF PREGNANCIES AND FULL ADOPTION OF THE NATIONAL SYSTEM FOR DEATH SURVEILLANCE AND RESPONSE. IN ADDITION, THE GRANT WILL EXPAND HEALTH EDUCATION FOR FAMILIES AS WELL AS ACCESS TO QUALITY CLINICAL CARE FOR PREGNANT WOMEN, MOTHERS AND BABIES.
