

Watch our Meeting HERE

We had quite the meeting this week, full of visitors and people who truly bring home into the world.

To begin with, we heard from Synergy, the High School STEM program that is project-based, focusing on awareness of businesses within the community. Synergy is raising money for IRAS to help with food insecurities in our community. IRAS has noted that there is a 300% increase in requests for help last year, compared to 2021. 419 families were served last year; this year, that number is already at 400. The two largest requests are for food and housing. In order to help IRAS, Synergy has put on a benefit.

The benefit will be on Wednesday, November 8th from 5 - 7pm at the Church at Lyons. All money raised will go to IRAS. One of the students commented that they focused on helping with IRAS because, "there are kids in our school, at every school in the Clinton Community School District, that benefit from the IRAS support so we could be sitting next to next someone in class and we don't know that they are in need of more support and more food so I think just being able to help people we to school with was a kind of a main drive for a lot of us." Their goal is to raise \$10,000 for Information Referral & Assistance Services.

Next, we heard from Molly Jones, the Clinton Student Adventures After School director with the Clinton County School District. Molly discussed how the program is at full capacity, with 50 kids being served, and has a waitlist of 75. Students receive a nutritious snack at the beginning of each program, there is academic assistance with tutoring from certificated, licensed teachers, and they go on field trips on a weekly basis! Jones also handles summer camp. She reported that they had 172 students last year in summer camp! The cost to the district is \$0. The funding comes from State funding. Molly received a financial donation from Rotary, on behalf of President Braydon's Presidential Project. Thank you, Molly, for everything you do for the Clinton community!

Finally, we heard from Lenny Weih, who introduced our last speaker, Shalynn Gerlach, who presented on "Sleep in Heavenly Peace." Mueller has been a social worker for the Camanche and Northeast school districts for five years. Nearly 3% of children under the age of 18 have no beds of their own, according to Sleep in Heavenly Peace (SHP). Muller stated, "We delivered our first bed on October 27th 2021 so it's been almost two years and we have delivered in Clinton County 156 beds. We have a wait list...of 50 beds and in Clinton alone, 134 beds have been delivered...The requirement for a bed is you just need a bed. We don't ask what is your income, we don't ask what your situation is. If you need a bed, we'll get you a bed." Mueller told us that the beds made through SHP come with a brand-new mattress, pillows, and blankets and that they use a special stain that guarantees no bed bugs will come into your home. They do standard twin-size beds and bunk beds. You can like SHP's Facebook HERE AND you can donate any amount HERE, from \$5 to \$500 (bunk bed).
