

WATCH OUR MEETING HERE

OUR PRESENTATION THIS WEEK WAS GIVEN TO US BY CLINTON COUNTY AUDITOR ERIC VAN LANCKER, VAN LANCKER HAS OVER 14 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN THIS ROLE AND TALKED EXTENSIVELY ABOUT CHANGES AND REGULATIONS IN THE LAW REGARDING VOTING.

SINCE 2021, SOME LAWS HAVE CHANGED REGARDING VOTING, INCLUDING VOTING POLLS CLOSING AT 8 PM AND IF YOU HAVE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT, IT NEEDS TO BE SUBMITTED WITHIN 20 DAYS

VAN LANCKER TALKED ABOUT THE DEWITT SATELITE VOTING. DUE TO ANOTHER CHANGE IN VOTING LAW, THIS WAS TAKEN AWAY BY THE STATE LEGISLATORS, VAN LANCKER STATED THAT LOCAL CONTROL OF VOTING WAS TAKEN AWAY. IN ORDER TO REVERSE THIS, A PETITION OF 100 SIGNATURES HAD TO BE COLLECTED TO OPEN THE DEWITT SATELLITE UP. "SO A SHOUT-OUT GOES TO A BIPARTISAN TEAM -- A DEMOCRAT AND A REPUBLICAN. GAIL POWELL AND CAROLYN BROWN AND ONE IS FROM DEWITT AND ONE IS FROM CLINTON. THEY WANTED TO KNOW WHAT THEY COULD DO TO HELP ME GET THAT SATELLITE OPEN AGAIN. WE SAT DOWN AND WENT THROUGH IT AND I SAID 'HERE, I NEED A HUNDRED SIGNATURES.' AND THEY WENT OUT AND GOT THEM SO WE ARE ABLE TO DO THAT SERVICE AND I REALLY APPRECIATE THAT THEY DID THAT FOR US."

VAN LANCKER ALSO TALKED ABOUT THE SECURITY OF PAPER BALLOTS. "WE HAVE THE BEST SYSTEM FOR ELECTIONS HERE IN THE STATE OF IOWA BECAUSE WE VOTE ON PAPER BALLOTS. THERE HAS NOT YET BEEN A MACHINE MADE THAT CAN HACK YOUR BALLOT. IF WE THINK SOMETHING HAS HAPPENED TO YOUR BALLOT, WE CAN ALWAYS OPEN UP THOSE BOXES BY ORDER OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND HAND COUNT THOSE. THAT, IS THE BEST BACKUP ON THE PLANET." VAN LANCKER ALSO MENTIONED IF YOU'RE VOTING AT HOME TO MAKE SURE YOU USE A BLACK, BALLPOINT PEN AND NOT A SHARPIE.



FOUNDATION MINUTE

WELCOME TO WEEK 4 OF RI'S MONTH OF COMMUNITY ECONOMIC & DEVELOPMENT

OCTOBER 24 IS WORLD POLIO DAY AND IT SEEMS APPROPRIATE FOR FM TO FORMALLY ANNOUNCE THE NEW COMMITMENT BY THE MELINDA AND BILL GATES FOUNDATION TOWARDS TOTAL ERADICATION OF POLIOMYELITIS FROM THE FACE OF THE PLANET. ON OCTOBER 16, 2022, AT THE WORLD HEALTH SUMMIT, THE BILL & MELINDA GATES FOUNDATION ANNOUNCED IT WILL COMMIT \$1.2 BILLION TO SUPPORT EFFORTS TO END ALL FORMS OF POLIO GLOBALLY. THE ANNOUNCEMENT WAS MADE AHEAD OF A KEY PLEDGING MOMENT THAT WAS CO-HOSTED BY GERMANY AND THE GLOBAL POLIO ERADICATION INITIATIVE (GPEI) ON OCTOBER 18.

THE NEW FINANCIAL COMMITMENT WILL SUPPORT IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GPEI'S POLIO ERADICATION STRATEGY 2022-2026, WHICH AIMS TO END WILD POLIOVIRUS IN THE LAST TWO ENDEMIC COUNTRIES—PAKISTAN AND AFGHANISTAN—AND STOP OUTBREAKS OF NEW VARIANTS OF THE VIRUS. THE FOUNDATION HAS CONTRIBUTED NEARLY \$5 BILLION TO GPEI.

"POLIO ERADICATION IS WITHIN REACH. BUT AS FAR AS WE HAVE COME, THE DISEASE REMAINS A THREAT. WORKING TOGETHER, THE WORLD CAN END THIS DISEASE," SAID BILL GATES, CO-CHAIR OF THE BILL & MELINDA GATES FOUNDATION. "THE FIGHT AGAINST POLIO HAS DONE FAR MORE THAN PROTECT CHILDREN AGAINST POLIO. IT HAS PLAYED A KEY ROLE IN STRENGTHENING HEALTH SYSTEMS," SAID MELINDA FRENCH GATES, CO-CHAIR OF THE BILL & MELINDA GATES FOUNDATION. "POLIO WORKERS HAVE BEEN ESPECIALLY VITAL IN RESPONDING TO COVID-19 AND REACHING COMMUNITIES ABOUT THE IMPORTANCE OF VACCINATION AGAINST PREVENTABLE DISEASES."

THE GLOBAL POLIO ERADICATION INITIATIVE IS A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP LED BY NATIONAL GOVERNMENTS WITH SIX CORE PARTNERS—ROTARY INTERNATIONAL, THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION (WHO), THE U.S. CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC), UNICEF, THE BILL & MELINDA GATES FOUNDATION, AND GAVI, THE VACCINE ALLIANCE.
