Former Rotarian Greg Fier presented to our club on Monday about the Bob Finch Memorial Fund. Multiple sclerosis (MS) is an unpredictable disease of the central nervous system that disrupts the flow of information within the brain and between the brain and body. There are three types of MS -- Relapsing-Remitting MS, Primary Progressive MS, and Secondary Progressive MS. The symptoms of MS can vary between fatigue, vision problems, weakness, paralysis, and cognition problems.

Fier met Bob Finch through mutual friends at a party. Fier wanted to help Finch with some more independent mobility and sent out emails to friends to help get money for Finch. Before he knew it, they had \$2,200 to get Finch a laptop which helped with communication and some independence for Finch. From there, The Finch Fund was established in memory of Bob Finch, who suffered from Multiple Sclerosis (MS). From age 56 he spent the last 15 years of his life in a nursing home because he lacked the resources to remain independent. Their mission is "To provide resources for people in our community who are affected by MS to help them maintain independence and quality of life."

The Bob Finch Memorial Fund (Finch Fund) - is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that provides resources for local MS victims to help them pay for home modifications, adaptive equipment, and assistive technologies all designed to let them maintain their independence and quality-of-life. Since its inception in 2018, the Finch Fund has approved 33 grants totaling \$81,160.82 for projects supporting local MS victims.


