

### FOUNDATION MINUTE

WELCOME TO WEEK 1 OF ROTARY INTERNATIONAL'S BASIC EDUCATION AND LITERACY MONTH.

THE ROTARY FOUNDATION ENABLES ROTARIANS TO ENSURE THAT ALL PEOPLE HAVE SUSTAINABLE ACCESS TO BASIC EDUCATION AND LITERACY BY INCREASING ADULT LITERACY IN COMMUNITIES AND WORKING TO REDUCE GENDER DISPARITY IN EDUCATION. TO KICK OFF THIS MONTH'S THEME. TRF RECENTLY AWARDED A \$30,000 GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP TO A GRADUATE OF THE INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND HUMANITARIAN EMERGENCIES PROGRAM OF THE LONDON SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS. SPONSORED BY THE ROTARY CLUB OF PAGOSA SPRINGS. COLORADO, CASEY LYNN CROW IS A CHOREOGRAPHER. BUSINESS OWNER AND A TRAVEL ENTHUSIAST. THE SECOND-YEAR DOCTORAL STUDENT, IN PUBLIC HEALTH AND POLICY AT THE LONDON SCHOOL OF HYGIENE AND TROPICAL MEDICINE, WILL USE HER GRANT RESEARCHING ACCESS TO SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH CARE IN HUMANITARIAN CRISES, PARTICULARLY FOR REFUGEES AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES. EXPRESSING HER GRATITUDE TO THE SPONSORING CLUBS, CROW PROMISED TO CARRY OUT THE HUMANITARIAN OBJECTIVES OF TRF AS A GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLAR, ADDING "THIS AWARD WILL ALLOW ME TO CONTINUE MY STUDIES AND CONDUCT MY FIELDWORK IN THE LARGEST REFUGEE CAMP IN THE WORLD, BIDI BIDI CAMP IN UGANDA, NEXT YEAR. I AM THRILLED TO REPRESENT ROTARY AS I CONTINUE MY RESEARCH AND DO MY BEST TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN THE WORLD."
