

Rotary - District 6000 "Literacy Minutes" September 2023

Week 1:

September is Basic Education and Literacy Month. Our goal as Rotarians is to strengthen the capacity of communities to support basic education and literacy, reduce gender disparity in education, and increase adult literacy. We support education for all children and literacy for children and adults. We are offering these "Literacy Minutes" to help your club understand the importance of literacy for all ages and in all parts of the world.

This week we begin our literacy journey with our youngest - our infants, toddlers, and preschoolers. There is more brain development and learning in these first three years than at any other time in a child's life. In fact, 80% of their brain is formed in this period. Early literacy practices "Talk with", "Sing with", "Play with", "Write with", and "Read with" infants, toddlers and preschoolers are great ways to help make these connections happen. These practices result in a strong foundation for the many other literacy skills needed in formal education.

What we can do as Rotarians:

Help empower our caregivers and their children by modeling these practices when we are with our children, our grandchildren or any child we see in the community.

- · When talking with the child, count to five silently to give the child a chance to respond and be part of the interaction. This creates an opportunity for a child's brain to "light up" the whole brain and create more experiences to aid in those connections.
- Everyone can talk with a child, even those who may not be able to read to a child. You can too!
