

# Rotary Membership Options

Effective 7/1/21

## Full Membership \$211/quarter

### Business Membership \$450 per quarter

Businesses and corporations designate two employees to become Rotarians and be active in the club with all of the normal requirements and responsibilities of club membership. The corporate CEO or his/her designee may attend any of the clubs meetings at any time without charge. In this example, RI would consider each corporate membership to count as two members. **The designated employees (Rotarians) may send any others to meetings in their place as a representative of the organization, up to 2 people may attend per meeting.**

### Family/Spouse membership – \$350 per quarter

There is often a primary regular attending member and one alternate member. The alternate member may be young adult children of the primary member or a partner or spouse. The alternate members can attend in the primary member's place or come along with their family member Rotarian. Both family members are Rotarians. If both Rotarians attend 3-4 meetings per month, the Club respectfully requests the members pay full dues to ensure Club costs are covered.

### Online / Non-Attending / Snowbird Member \$150/quarter, includes Paul Harris

This member is a full member of Rotary, but is unable or chooses not to attend in-person lunch meetings. Their membership is discounted due to no meal costs. As they are occasionally able to attend a lunch meeting, they pay \$15 to attend the meeting.

## Notes:

- **2021-22 GOAL: 100 member goal as Club to keep dues at current levels.**
- \$211 Regular dues includes: \$45 RI/District Dues (\$46.53 last invoice), \$4 Polio Plus, \$25 Paul Harris (Optional), \$137 Meals & club administration.
- We are currently paying \$14 per meal (included tax & tip) rounded up to nearest 30, 40, 50 people attending in-person, including guests.
- Budget runs \$75,000 - 70,000 in total expenses (minus \$8,000 scholarships paid by fellowship and Foundation, and minimum \$2,500 from fundraiser) = \$250 quarterly per member based on 75 members
- \$25 Paul Harris quarterly is optional, but each member giving \$100 count points towards our Community Grant application to fund projects like Josh the Otter and Home Run Readers.
- Fellowship "Scholarship Fund" giving: \$25-30 per quarter per member covers scholarship costs = \$8,000. \$3 per meeting, if attending all 48 meetings, consider more if not able to attend regularly.

### ON HOLD

#### Evening Club Member

As an alternative to a noon meeting, the Club and Board would consider adding this option **once we have a committed leader to spearhead evening meetings.**

### ON HOLD for COVID

#### Associate / Service Above Self Membership \$125/quarter

- Schedules 10 hours of service per month with Board.
- This member is a full member of Rotary but pays reduced costs. In exchange for reduced dues, and in the spirit of "service above self" they commit to provide 10 hours per month in service to the Club, tracking sheet provided to Board each month. As they choose to attend a lunch meeting, they pay \$15 to attend to cover lunch costs.
