
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ROTARY CLUB OF DES MOINES FOUNDATION

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The Secretary of State TO: State of Iowa:

I, the undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Iowa Nonprofit Corporation Act under Chapter 504A of the Code of Iowa, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

I.

The name of the corporation is Rotary Club of Des Moines Foundation.

II.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States internal revenue law).

III.

The address of its initial registered office in the State of Iowa is Room 300, Hotel Fort Des Moines, in the City of Des Moines, County of Polk and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Judith E. Gustaveson.

IV.

The number of directors, constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is 11 and the names and addresses of the initial Board of Directors are:

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No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except as the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments of distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States revenue law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law).

VI.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educa-

tional, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States internal revenue law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the State of Iowa in and for Polk County exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

VII.

The following provisions shall control the activities of the corporation:

- (1) the corporation will distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws).
- (2) the corporation will not engage in any act of selfdealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws).
- (3) the corporation will not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws).
- (4) the corporation will not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws).
- (5) the corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws).
