- RSVPs are on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Only 40 can be accommodated at this time.
- For the time being, we will not have guests in person, so that we can give priority to our current members. Guests are still permitted – and encouraged – virtually.

DMAM ROTARY IS SELLING OLSON MASKS made with a hepa filter as a fund raiser to support our Foundation or a current COVID-19 community service project. Please bring the exact amount needed to purchase the number of masks you need. Cost: \$5 per mask; \$10 for Iowa or Iowa State themed masks. Upon request, Angie is willing to make custom masks from specialty cotton prints if you provide the fabric.

Masks are available in 5 sizes: XS, S, M, L, XL

- o Under age 2 - no masks (Syds concern)
- o X-Small -under 95 lbs.
- o Small 95 - 140 lbs.
- o Medium 140 - 225 lbs. (fits most adults)
- o Large 225+
- o XL - Men with beards

Fabric is 100% cotton including thread - patterns vary depending on supply. Kirby's Hepa Filter provides an additional level of protection. Masks are designed as a headband that can be easily modified to ear loops. Headbands work better for hearing aids.
